Invenergy has completed development on 4 sustainable energy projects in Oklahoma and is pursuing additional opportunities in the state.



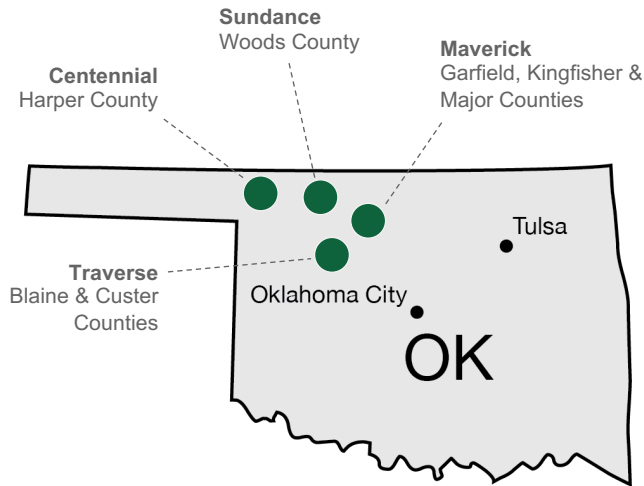

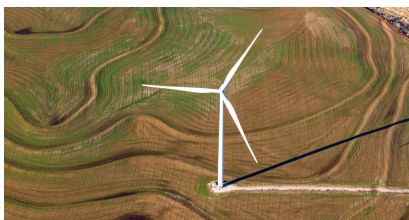
